

# Sample Circle Structure - “All Members” circle modification

This is an example of an organization where all those involved have in common the role of “member,” and where at least some broad or general or high-level decisions are reserved for the circle of “All Members” to make. Remaining decisions are delegated to the General circle, which can then delegate further to sub-circles doing more specific work. This modification may be useful for co-housing groups, co-ops, and other forms of collective ownership.

Which decisions are in the domain of the “All Members” circle and which are delegated will vary from organization to organization.

NOTE that for organizations that have a Top circle, the All Members circle may link to the Top circle rather than the General circle.
